

# Invalid Table Alias or Column Reference

## Problem



Job failed with the following error message

FAILED: SemanticException [Error 10004]: Line 3:29 Invalid table alias or column reference 'order\_id': (possible column names are: \_c0, \_c1)

## Failed Query:

```
SELECT
TD_DATE_TRUNC(
'day',
CAST(
CONV(SUBSTR(order_id,
0,
8),
16,
10) AS BIGINT
),
'America/Los_Angeles'
),
COUNT(*)
FROM
pj_db.pj_table
GROUP BY
1
ORDER BY
1
```

## Cause

The issue caused by the Hive ORDER BY with a column number. Table aliases in order by clause lead to semantic analysis failure

## Solution

1. Use column alias in `order by` instead of column number

## Working Query:

```
SELECT
TD_DATE_TRUNC(
'day',
CAST(
CONV(SUBSTR(order_id,
0,
8),
16,
10) AS BIGINT
),
'America/Los_Angeles'
),
COUNT(*)
FROM
pj_db.pj_table
GROUP BY
1
ORDER BY
ORDER_ID
```
